## EVENT AND ARTIST RECEPTION FOR DAVID LEASER AT THE HUNTINGTON

SAN MARINO, CA - On Saturday, September 10, 2011, nearly 400 guests attended an artist's reception for David Leaser at the Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens near Los Angeles.

The event featured 11 selections from David Leaser's *Nightflowers* collection, including a preview work from his upcoming "Nightflowers II" collection. Author and fine art photographer David Leaser has developed a process using sophisticated imaging techniques, including technology from NASA's missions to Mars, which critics are calling *dettagli* because of the extreme detail they exhibit.

The International Photography Awards recognized Leaser's *Nightflowers* with a silver award in the Nature: Flowers category. More than 8,000 submissions from 90 countries competed for the 2011 International Photography Awards, the largest to date.

The 11 large art pieces from the Nightflowers collection that are on display include:

The artist reception was part of a series, titled "Focus on Flowers," which paired Leaser's artwork with science. Using microscopes, visitors were able to compare the intricacies of the flowers through the microscopic lens against the large-scale canvases in the collection.

The Nightflowers collection will be on display in the Botanical Building (adjacent the Conservatory) through November 1 and can be viewed with general admission during normal business hours, except Sundays.

Through November 1, visitors can also attend the Huntington free of charge to attend a special "Focus on Flowers" demonstration in the Botanical Building. The series will run on Saturday mornings through November 1 in the Botanical Building from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. by invitation.
